- Into this ball he was compelled to chant a mantra of which he knew not the language or the meaning.
- As a child he was obsessed with the desire to end mankind's suffering.

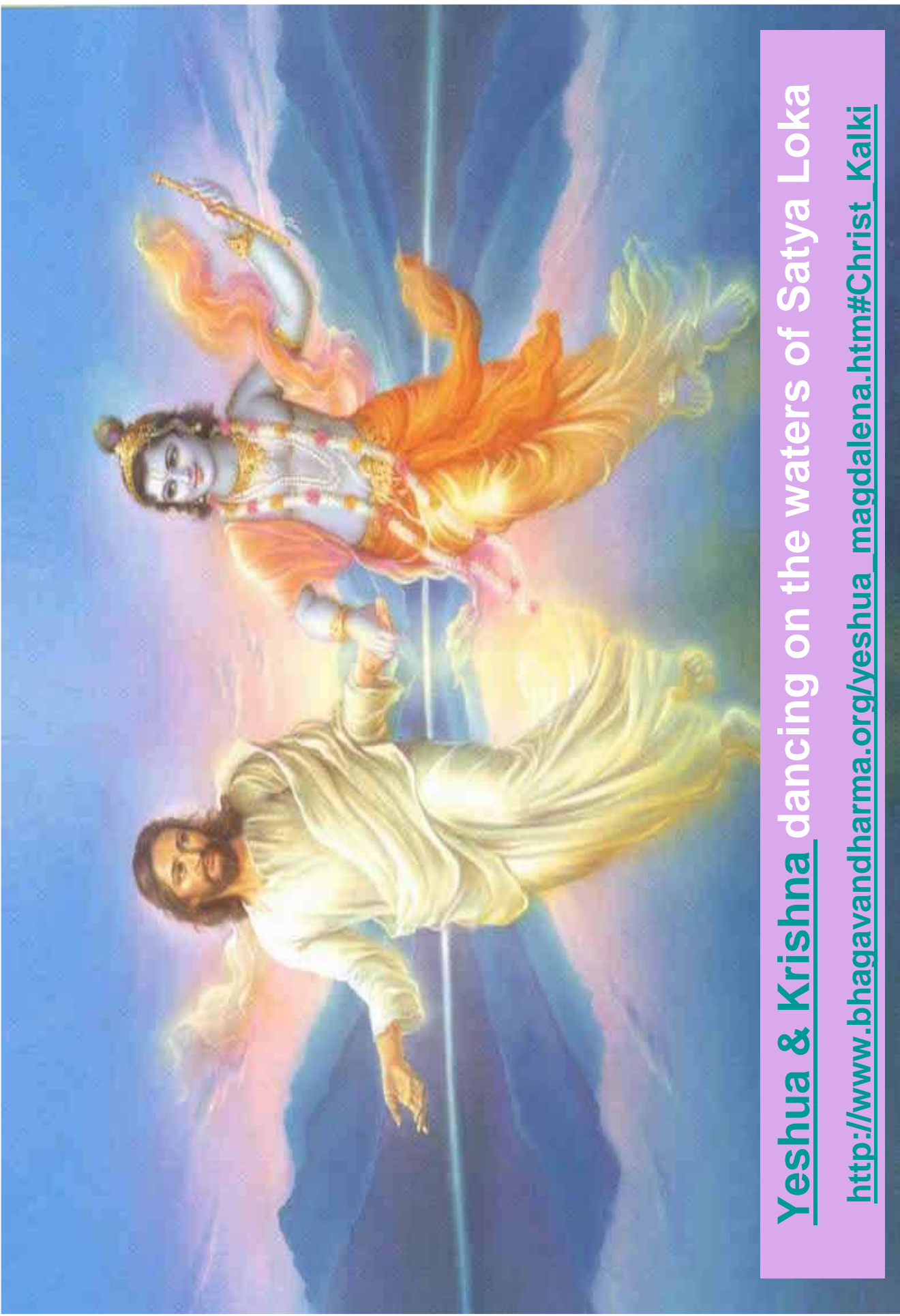


**The Golden Ball of Grace in the hands of Mary Magdalene and her child John... statue found on the central altar at the Magdalene Church at Montsegur, south France.**

# History

- In 1989 Amma Bhagavan's son Krishna, who was a student at their Jivashram school, came to Bhagavan telling him that he had experienced the descent of a golden ball in through his crown chakra, resting as a being in his heart chakra.
- Bhagavan asks his son who the being is that is in his heart. Krishna does not know so Bhagavan sends Krishna away to find out who it is.

- A wave of profound mystical experiences sweeps over the students of the Jivashram school.

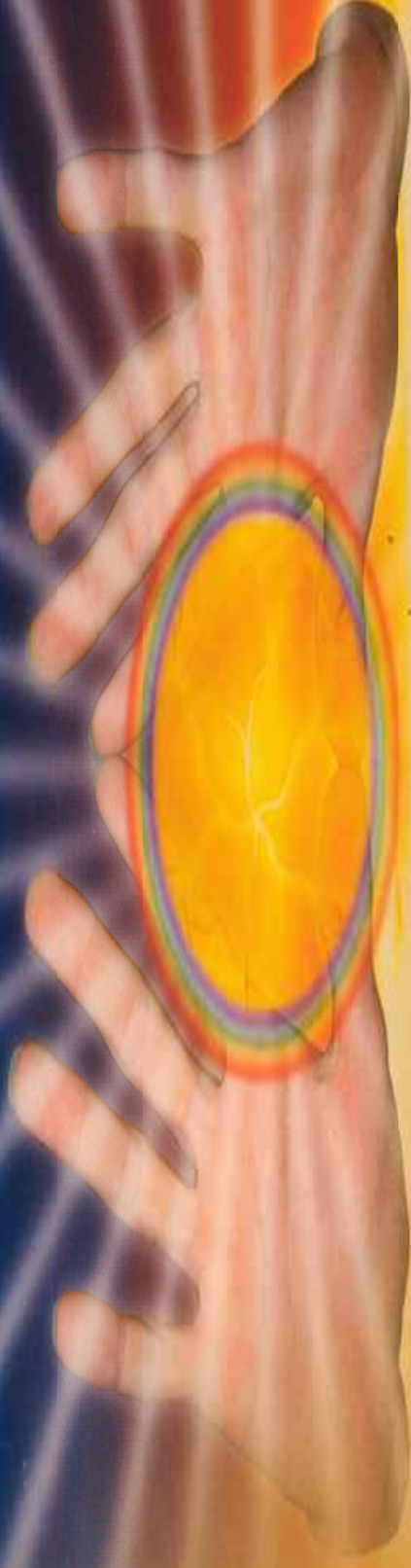


## History

- Bhagavan withdraws the phenomenon, as the world is not yet ready for it.
- The phenomenon is reborn in 2003.
- In the following year the first group of westerners undergoes a 21 day Oneness Blessing process at Bhagavan's ashram in southern India.
